

ARBORS TENNIS COURTS

1. Sign-up Procedure - Court #1 - PINK SHEET

- a. Weekly Sheet (pink) will be posted the Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, for the week ahead.
- b. Court time is on a first come, first serve basis.
- c. Players may sign up for a court in advance only if the court is occupied and already reserved up until the time you wish to play. You may sign up only for the next available time. If your name is posted as an advanced sign-up, this is a violation of court #1 sign-up procedures and another player will have the right to erase your name.
- d. All players must be present and ready to play at their designated time- otherwise the court is available to anyone for “free time.”

2. Sign-up Procedure - Court #2 - WHITE SHEET

- a. Weekly Sheet (white) will be posted the Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, for the week ahead.
- b. Court time is on a reservation basis.
- c. Players may sign up for only two tennis time slots in advance for that week.
- d. In the event the court is not being used, the court time is open to anyone on a first come, first serve basis. This means that you can play on the vacant court even if you have signed up for your quota of two time slots for that week.
- e. All players must be present and ready to play at their designated time - otherwise the court is available to anyone for “free time.”
- f. If you cannot make your scheduled sign-up time, erase your name to make the time available for someone else.
- g. Please do not monopolize signing up on court #2 for the same period(s) in consecutive weeks at a time.

3. Time Frames

- a. One hour for singles - One and one-half hours for doubles.
- b. If players leave the court before their time is up, or do not show up for a previously signed-up time, that court becomes “free time” available for play only until the next previously signed-up players are due to go on.

Example: Players A on from 10 to 11, leave the court at 10:30, a half hour before Players B, signed up for 11 to 12, go on. Players C, not previously signed-up, may play from 10:30 to 11:00 “free time,” but must give up the court for Players B at 11).

4. General Rules

- a. Residents are prohibited from receiving payments for any type of tennis instruction.
- b. When both courts are in use at the same time, players are limited to three balls per court.
- c. Courts are to be used for tennis only.
- d. Do not enter the court while a point is being played.
- e. Proper tennis attire is to be worn at all times (this includes regulation shoes, no bathing suits, and shirts must be worn by men players).
- f. Keep a low noise profile on the courts.
- g. No play before 8:30 AM.
- h. Children under 14 are not permitted on the court during prime time hours, unless accompanied by an adult. Prime time hours are all day Saturday, Sunday and Holidays, and after 5:00 PM on weekdays.
- i. **The courts are available for singles and doubles play. Group play or tennis “clinics” are not allowed ** Revised 2001****

The Arbors tennis rules and regulations have worked satisfactorily over the years, but in order to function without controversy, residents must understand the system and exercise some degree of cooperation.

TOURNAMENTS

During the course of the summer, there may be one or more organized community tournaments. Specifically assigned tournament playing time(s) may have precedence over regular play, on either or both courts, at the discretion of the tennis or tournament committee.
