GENERAL INFORMATION:

COURT IS DESIGNED FOR PLATFORM TENNIS ONLY, AND CANNOT BE USED FOR OTHER RACQUET GAMES OR ANY RECREATIONAL BALL PLAYING.

COURT IS FOR DAYTIME AND NIGHTTIME PLAY. NO PLAY IS PERMITTED BEYOND 10:00PM. ALSO, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE HOMES THAT ARE NEAR THE COURT, PLEASE KEEP THE NOISE AT REASONABLE LEVELS.

THE COURT IS FOR THE EXCLUSIVE USE OF ARBORS RESIDENTS. GUESTS MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A RESIDENT.

FOLLOWING WINTER STORMS, THE ARBORS WORK CREW WILL SHOVEL SNOW OFF THE COURT. IF ONE WISHES TO DO ADDITIONAL SHOVELLING, USE **PLASTIC**, NOT METAL SHOVEL.

FOR SECURITY REASONS, THERE ARE PADLOCKS ON THE SCREEN DOORS. FOR COMBINATIONS, CALL THE ARBORS OFFICE.

RESERVING COURT TIME:

Court time is in hour segments.

Sign-up sheets are in the sign-up box at courtside, posted on a monthly basis.

Include your house number and name on sign-up sheet.

Advanced sign-ups are permitted.
